Please allow <u>at least 2 weeks</u> for your recommendation to be completed. For example, if recommendations for your school are due on 7/15, all recommendation materials must be submitted no later than 7/1. A request for recommendation not submitted within the required timeline cannot guarantee you a recommendation.

4. Personal Statement	Alpha Chi Omega has 5 valued criteria for membership, which are detailed below. You should write a personal statement that addresses how you believe you fulfill each of these qualities. This statement should be $\frac{1}{2}$ page – 1 page in length.
